




Screening Recommendation for AAA

Dr. Duangnapa Cuddy, DO, FACOS, RPVI

The Society for Vascular Surgery recommends a one-time ultrasonography screening for Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (AAA) in all men and women aged 65 to 75 years with a history of tobacco use, men 55 years or older with a family history of AAA, and women 65 years or older who have smoked or have a family history of AAA.

The book of discussion will be "The Hospital" by Brian Alexander.


